

# TAG QUESTIONS



- We use tag questions at the end of statements to ask for confirmation or to validate information.
- An **affirmative statement** is followed by a **negative tag**:  
You like French food, **don't you?**
- A **negative statement** is always followed by a **positive tag**:
  - Your dad **isn't** engineer, **is he?**
- The tag question is always separated from the statement by a comma.
  - He **can** play table tennis, **can't he?**



- The verb of the tag must watch that on the statement:  
if the verb in the statement is **to be**, so is the tag:
  - It **is** going to rain, **isn't it**?



- When you use modals such as **can, could, must, should** and **will** in statements, then that same modal should appear in the tag.

- He **shouldn't** play with that, **should** he?
- They **must** be here by now, **mustn't** they?
